

TRAVEL VACCINATION CHARGES – March 2017

Tetanus/Diphtheria & Polio (Revaxis)	Free of charge
Cholera (Dukoral – oral suspension) (needs to be ordered in especially)	Free of charge
Hepatitis 'A' (Epazal or Avaxim)	Free of Charge
Hepatitis A&B Combined	Free of Charge
Hepatitis A and Typhoid Combined	Free of Charge
Hepatitis 'B' For special groups only	Free of Charge
Not available on NHS for travel but if requested there is a charge of:	£40.00 per injection – (Course of 3)
Children	£25 per injection - (Course of 3)
Japanese 'B' Encephalitis (needs to be ordered in especially)	£90.00 per injection (Usually need a Course of 2 injections. Needs to be completed at least 10 days before travel)
Meningitis ACWY (needs to be ordered in especially)	£65.00
Rabies (needs to be ordered in especially)	£55.00 each – (Course of 3 injections)
Tick-bourne Encephalitis (needs to be ordered in especially)	£65 per injection – Course of 3 injections)
Typhoid	Free of charge (unless requested by patient but not recommended for the country being visited – £30.00)
Yellow Fever	£60.00 (needs to be given at least 2 weeks before travel)
Malaria prophylaxis including doxycycline Mefloquine and Malarone	£15 (admin fee) for each private prescription

Please note private clinics will charge for Cholera, Diphtheria, Tetanus and Polio, Hepatitis A and Typhoid, Hepatitis A & B and Typhoid which we are able to offer free of charge.
